Our Program Provides The Following For Accepted Interns


- Individual and group psychotherapy supervision weekly
- Opportunities to facilitate psychotherapeutic and psychoeducational groups
- Counseling experience in individual, couple, family, and play therapy
- School-based therapy
- Case consultation with peers and supervision staff

Requirements For Acceptance Into The Program

- Prior traineeship/practicum placement or equivalent work experience
- Prior experience with victims and/or perpetrators of violent crimes
- Coursework in family systems, psychotherapeutic theories, and child and adult development
- Minimum 20-hour weekly commitment for a minimum of one year

Interview Materials Required

- Resume highlighting coursework, previous traineeships/practicums, relevant work experience
- Cover letter indicating desired start date
- Two reference letters
